We are now in the process of having our web page, as designed by the Chattanooga State group, implemented for us. As it stands right now the web site will contain a main page with links to other pages, (Kenosha, Dixie District, learning tapes, sample music, etc.), a Board of Directors page, a page for history and Information about the chorus, a what is and history of barbershop page, an upcoming events page (calendar), a page for our quartets with links to their individual pages.
