BOWERY STREET' BOYS

This registered barbershop quartet is the current championship quartet of the Dixie District of the SPEBSQSA, a six-state area covering the entire Southeast U.S. The group was originally formed in 1979 with the current foursome coming together in January of 1982. Since that time, the Tuscaloosa-based quartet has quickly risen to the top in barbershopping. In 1983, the Bowery Street Boys were one of the two Southeast representatives to compete in the Society's International Competition in Seattle, Washington and this past fall the group captured its coveted quartet championship in Columbia, S.C.

Quartet members are:

Tenor: Keith Jennings. Keith is an auto parts salesman and a 10 year member in the SPEBSQSA, having started at the ripe old age of 15. Despite his youth, his experience gives him a lead role in the direction and development of the quartet.

Lead: Charles Foster. Charles is the "master musician" of the group. In addition to his singing, he is an accomplished pianist and trombone player, a choir director, and has performed in musical groups throughout the country. In his "spare" time, he's a graduate student and lab instructor in computer science at the University of Alabama, as well as a programmer for a law firm.

Bass: James Lollar. James is a 7 year member for the Society and currently serves as area counselor for the organization for a major part of Alabama. He is a doctoral student in marketing at Alabama as well as an instructor.

Baritone: Bobby Wooldridge. Bobby is an 11 year member of the Society and the certified "old man" of the quartet. Since the quartet's formation in 1979, he has held 3 parts in the group, adding lead and bass to his current slot. Bobby also serves in an administrative capacity in the six-state Dixie District as President. When not barbershopping, he's an attorney in private practice in Tuscaloosa.

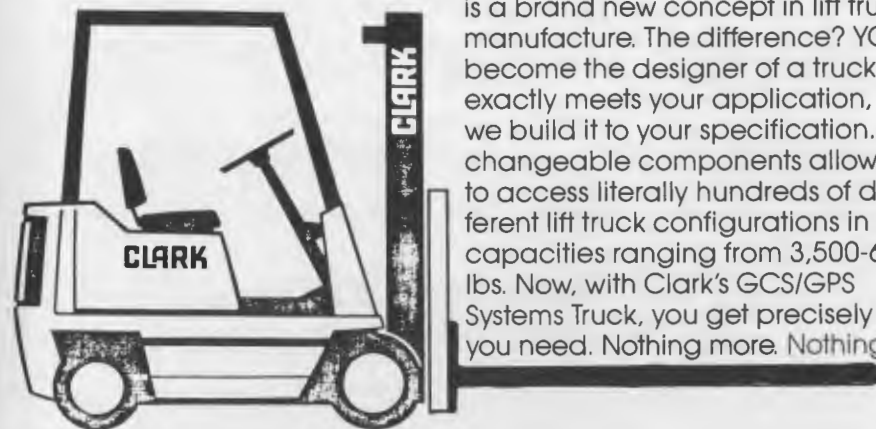

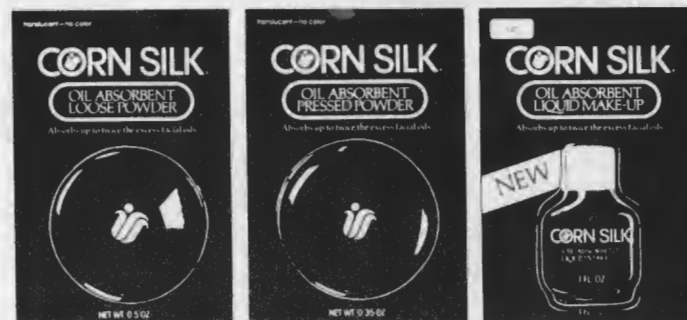

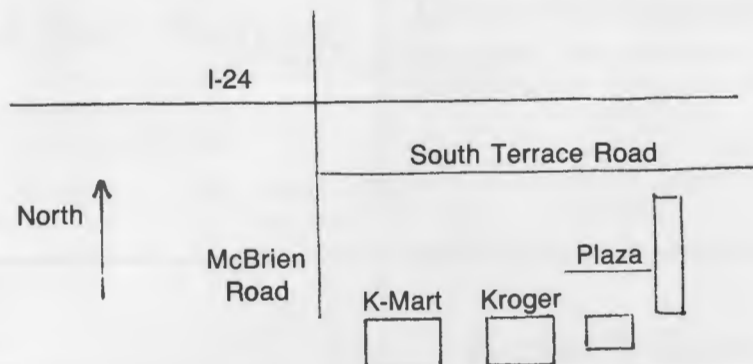
