These dreams were fulfilled as they joined hands in New Orleans, singing "Keep the Whole World Singing," after a rousing ovation declared Keepsake the 1992 international quartet champion.

A gifted musician, Paul has been the director of the Chattanooga Choo Choo Barbershop Chorus for the last nine years. Although a natural bass, he can sing all four parts. The chorus, under Paul's direction, has continued to improve its standing in the Dixie District of the Barbershop Singing Society.
